


The Impact

To date, HOPE has served more than 2 million individuals; directed more than \$1.5 billion in private capital to America's low-wealth communities; utilized over 20,000 HOPE Corps volunteers, and currently serves more than 300 cities in the U.S. and around the world. We measure our impact through the Gallup-HOPE Index, a historic 100-year partnership with Gallup.
