

Operation HOPE

Operation HOPE was founded in 1992 and is now the largest economic education and empowerment organization for underserved communities, families, youth and adults. Through our work, we convert check-cashing customers into banking customers, renters into homeowners, small business dreamers into small business owners, and minimum wage workers into living wage workers.

Operation HOPE is rated four-stars by Charity Navigator, it's highest rating available. To date, HOPE has served more than 2 million individuals; directed more than \$1.5 billion in private capital to America's low-wealth communities; utilized over 20,000 HOPE Corps volunteers, and currently serves more than 300 cities in the U.S. and around the world. We measure our impact through the Gallup-HOPE Index, a historic 100-year partnership with Gallup.

An Exceptional Gathering of Extraordinary Voices

The HOPE Global Forums carefully curate a broad range of guest speakers to lend their influential voice and perspective to our program. From Heads of State, Fortune 500 CEO's and Nobel Prize Winners, to leading entrepreneurs, philanthropists and public policy officials, expect to experience a diverse array of accessible global shapers and innovators.

Event Format

The event consists of Keynote Addresses, Plenary Sessions (moderated conversations), Breakouts and Working Group Breakout Sessions. Each unpacks the theme of the event into specific areas of focus (women and girls, technology, entrepreneurship, youth, investment in low wealth communities, cities, etc.). Working Groups feature a moderated panel discussion and breakout session with facilitators, scribes and iPads at each table, capturing "real time" discussion and fostering commitments to action.

Special Events

A series of resonant, off-site activities provide context to the event while offering attendees the opportunity to connect and collaborate while exploring Atlanta. A series of receptions, dinners, walking tours, mixers and sponsored events offer something for every delegate. Events have been held at the National Center for Civil and Human Rights, Coca-Cola Global Headquarters, CNN Center and also included a Walking Tour of the MLK Historical District. Sponsored events were hosted by Coca-Cola, MSNBC and Essence Magazine.

Annual Meeting Location and Venue

The 2017 HOPE Global Forums | Annual Meeting will be held in Atlanta, GA at the Marriott Marquis Hotel, rated one of the Top 100 Meeting Hotels in the U.S. As host city, the backdrop of Atlanta's rich history and inspirational attractions combine to create a city with Southern charm and world-class sophistication.
